

## **The Derby Motor Boat Club**

### **DINGHIES AND TENDERS : Change of Rules**

**2(a)** of the Rules of Membership of Derby Motor Boat Club Ltd states, as from publication of this notice:

“Each full member in addition to becoming a subscriber to the Memorandum and Articles of Association shall pay the annual subscription for the time being in force. This will entitle the member to the exclusive use of a mooring suitable for their particular boat. Any person joining the Club must be the sole or joint owner of that boat. The names of other joint owners will be recorded but they will have no rights of membership. The Council at its sole discretion may grant a dispensation from Rule 2(d) to a joint owner whose name was recorded at the time that one of their number became a member. Except for those vessels required for Club use and marked “For DMBC Use Only”, no dinghy, tender, canoe, or similar craft may be left at the Club at any time, unless securely stored on the member’s boat.”

This Rule change has been made due to the constant issues encountered by the Council over several years in managing the facility.
